INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

1. Tables are 8-foot banquet tables.
2. We strongly encourage you to have your exhibit/activity be as interactive as possible and reflect the festival's theme to demonstrate responsible stewardship of the environment.
3. Tables will be outdoors under a tent. Please bring your own chairs. Space is available for activities in an open area. Please note specific requests on your application.
4. *Please pick up trash in and around your booth. Thank you.*
5. The festival area will be open by 7:30 a.m. on June 7th, to accommodate set up of spaces. Please have your exhibit set up by 10:00 a.m. Tables will be labeled by organization name.
6. We would appreciate an overview of your exhibit or activity on the form.
7. In keeping with our theme, we ask that your exhibits do not include selling or giving away plastic bags, Styrofoam or polystyrene, helium balloons, six-pack rings and anything else that can be harmful to wildlife or human life. We ask that you lead by example and encourage the use of recycled products where possible.
8. We suggest rocks, bungee cords, etc. to keep any literature from blowing away.
9. The Barnegat Bay National Estuary Program retains the right to decline a request to participate. Participation does not constitute endorsement by the Barnegat Bay National Estuary Program or other sponsors.

To reserve your space, the form should be completed and returned by **WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1, 2009**. Please let us know as soon as possible of your intent to participate. If your plans change after you return the form, please call to cancel so someone else may use your space.

DIRECTIONS TO WANAMAHER COMPLEX IN ISLAND HEIGHTS:

Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 82. Take Route 37 east to Vaughn/West End Avenues. Take a right on West End Avenue, go up the hill (keeping "Triangle Park" where the "Welcome to Island Heights" sign is located on your right), and take a left on Summit Avenue, then a right on East End Avenue (almost to the water). Cross over Van Sant Avenue and take your first left into the police station/municipal complex driveway (just after a small playground). You will be able to park your car in this parking lot, which is also used for the Post Office.
